INSTRUCTIONS FOR SELECTION OF VALUE ADDITION COURSES (VACs) (FOR INCOMING SECOND YEAR STUDENTS)

1. The VAC selection form will be open **from 11.00 am on 29 June 2026 (Monday) till 05.00 pm on 30 June 2026 (Tuesday)**.
2. Each student may **submit the form only once**. Once the form closes, allocations will not be made unless satisfactory reason and evidence is provided regarding the failure to fill the forms on time.
3. Selections should be made with careful consideration, as **requests for changes to papers will not be entertained at a later stage**.
4. Course allocations will be made on a **first-come, first-served basis**. Once a course reaches its maximum seating capacity, students will no longer be able to select that paper.
5. Final **course allocations will be published on the college website**. Students are requested to check the website for updates, as **individual notifications regarding allocation will not be sent via email**.
6. All incoming Semester III students are required to choose one Value Addition Course (VAC) for the upcoming semester.
7. Students may opt for a VAC paper offered by their parent department, provided that its syllabus does not overlap with the content of any DSC, DSE, GE, VAC, or SEC course they are currently studying or are expected to study. Please review the prerequisite information thoroughly.
8. A total of 14 Value Addition Courses are available for Semester III. Students are free to select any one from this list. However, **a student should not choose a VAC paper that has already been taken in an earlier semester**, even if the same paper is offered by a different department in the current semester. 11. To avoid technical issues, students should ensure a stable internet connection before submitting the form. Additionally, all students are required to **keep a screenshot of the submission confirmation**, clearly showing the time, student's name, and roll number, after completing the form.
