



Action Taken Report 2022 – 2023

- AQAR 2021-22 was submitted to NAAC within the stipulated timeline.
- The prime focus of IQAC in the academic year 2022-23 has been to strengthen the research culture in the College. In line with this vision, A five day Qualitative Research Workshop was organised in July 2022. The College published an edited volume entitled Pandemic Perspectives: Praxis, Policy and Pedagogies, The book hosts a variety of perspectives within economic, social and development research studies, situating impacts and learnings from the pandemic providing the reader with contemporary and useful information. Most contributors in the book are College faculty. The College Journal, The JMC Review, came out with its VI edition in 2022.
- Various talks, Seminars, special lectures on aspects related to quality enhancement in higher education, research, publications, Assessment, Community Engagement were organized.
- As the University ushered into the second year of NEP 2020, IQAC organised many orientation and counseling sessions for the students in order to acquaint them and assist them in making informed choices about their courses. IQAC provided an interface amongst departments for a smooth implementation of Special Orientation Programmes were held for apprising the students and faculty about the changes implemented under the National Education Policy 2020. An NEP Committee has been formed to oversee the implementation issues and Challenges faced by the students and faculty with regard to the new Curricular framework.
- The IQAC also organized special programmes like the visit of Principals of the Government Degree Colleges from Andhra Pradesh in collaboration with NIEPA.
- U.S. Secretary of Commerce Gina Raimondo visited the College in March 2023, to Commemorate Women's History Month and the Important United States-India Relationship.
- The Web-based portal created for capturing, analysing and reporting data from Students, Faculty, Departments and Societies has been streamlined to adapt to the

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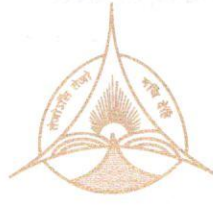

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reporting requirements of the College for NAAC, NIRF, AISHE etc. In addition to this a robust system to process the choices of the courses offered to the students in NEP has been designed.

- A Faculty Felicitation Programme was organized by the IQAC to recognize the academic and research contributions of six faculty members promoted to the post of Professor. In addition to this one faculty has been promoted to the post of Professor, three faculty members to the post Associate Professor and five Assistant Professors from Stage 11 to Stage 12. This is a major step taken towards the career advancement of the faculty members.
- A Community Engagement Centre was set up in collaboration with International Association for Human Values. to organize, facilitate, conduct social and development programs for the needy. Examples of such programs include Skill Development training, Digital Literacy Workshops, Financial Literacy Workshops, Menstrual Health and Hygiene Awareness Programs etc. for underprivileged girls and women.
- Maintenance of infrastructure as well as upkeep of safety and security equipment is carried out regularly in a systematic manner through professional experts.
- The IQAC under the leadership of the Principal has taken the initiative to collect and analyse the feedback from all stakeholders, namely, students, faculty, administrative staff, parents, alumni and employers. The principal communicated the feedback at the appropriate forums and initiated corrective measures wherever necessary.
- Academic and Administrative Audit for the years 2021-22 and 2022-23 was held in June 2023. Eminent academicians from the domain of Education policy, administration and research were invited as experts to provide feedback to departments and suggest ways for further improvement in the teaching learning and research activities of the departments of the College.
