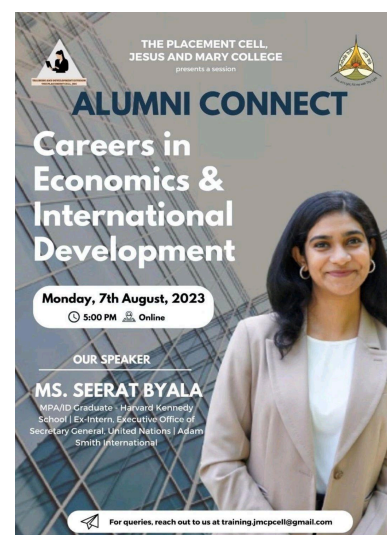

By: Ms. Palak Bhel, King's College London

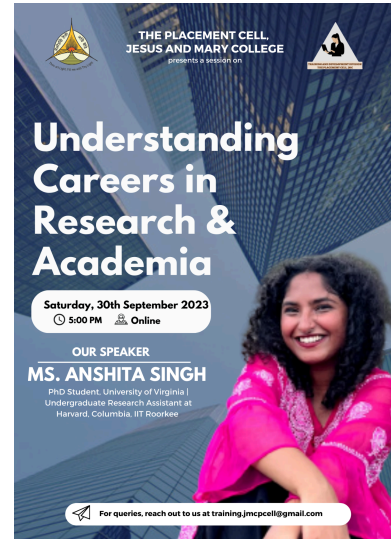

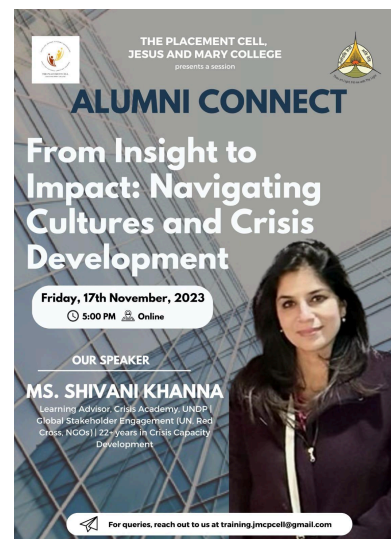
