

The following items were be collected:

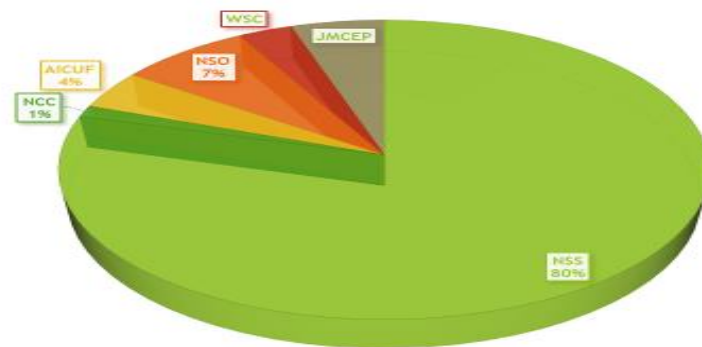
- One side used paper/ notebooks

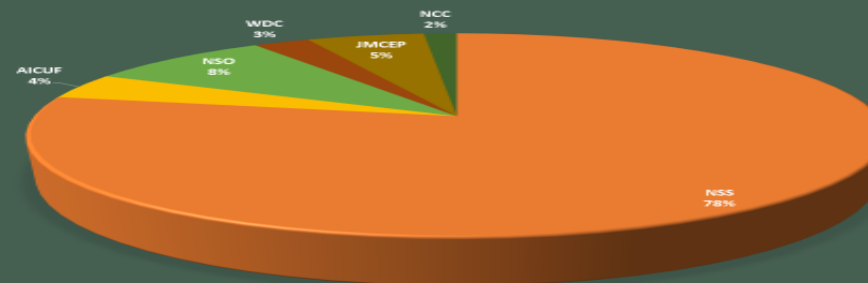
