How does the Transfer Program work?

Students are accepted into the transfer program during the 1st year of study at your institution and transfer to CCNY after completing 4 Semesters of study. The process works as follows:

- The Director of Operations from Concordia's Chennai Office or his designate will make a detailed presentation to students and parents on the day of Orientation at your college
- Once appraised of the details and costs, students will be encouraged to fill out an interest card following the orientation
- Interested students will be contacted by the India Office as well as the campus coordinator to provide necessary details
- **Students opting for 2 Semesters study (2+1 Program) will be required to take Concordia classes during their study in their Indian institute. The credits will be transferred to Concordia.**
- Students will complete a total of 5 courses of 3 credits each in their years of study in India which will give them 1 year to finish in Concordia.
- During the 4 semesters of study at your institution, the Chennai office as well as the New York Office of Admission will regularly interact with the student to maintain ties to Concordia College.

Eligibility and Estimated Cost to attend Concordia

Normally, students will need to have an **average of 70%** during their semesters at the Indian institution. Students must also score **80 or above in the TOEFL** exam and be recommended in accordance to the process established by your institution. **TOEFL scores are waived for students whose First language is English.**

Concordia offers generous scholarships based on merit. Though figures may change from year to year, the student should expect the following expenses.

For students entering Concordia in Fall of 2018

2+1 Program (Five - Credit Courses)

Concordia Courses in India will be offered Online and will be taught by Concordia faculties. Cost of each courses is US \$ 400.

Interested students taking the 2+3 program can also take few Concordia classes in India to reduce their load at Concordia.

Total cost of attendance for Fall 2018 is **USD 54540 per year**. This cost is inclusive of tuition, lodging and meals and Indirect cost (Health Insurance, book and supplies, transportation, personal expenses).

The following scholarships are available for students with an 80 ibt in TOEFL (TOEFL score waiver as applicable) and ;

65-70% average marks during the 4 semesters will be awarded **USD 10,000** bringing the annual cost (2 Semesters) to **USD 44540**.

85% average marks during the 4 Semesters with required SAT Score will be eligible for up to **USD 15,000/Year** bringing the annual cost (2 semesters) to **USD 39540**. Students have to make a formal application to be admitted to the Fellows Program and be accepted into the program to receive this scholarship.

Concordia Classes in India will cost about **USD 2000 for 5 Courses**.
(USD 400 / course)

India Office

The India Office, located in Chennai, will work directly with the student once they have formally registered for the program. We encourage you to register and start taking Concordia Online Classes in your First year so you can distribute your load in the Second year. During your 4th semester, India Office will assist the student to complete their formal application (Common App) to secure admission to Concordia. Once they are admitted and receive their I 20, students will be assisted to assemble the required documents for their visa application including financial affidavits. Once the necessary documents are in place, the India Office will arrange for their visa interview. After obtaining their visa, students will proceed to make travel arrangements to begin their journey to Concordia!

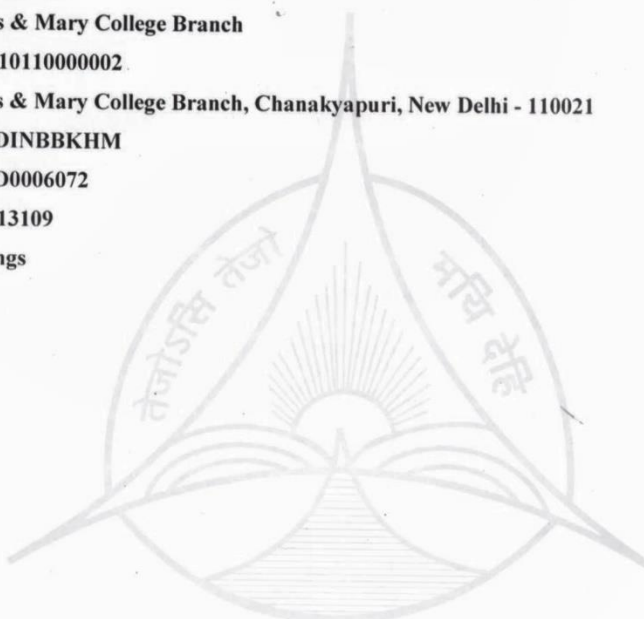

Greetings from Concordia College, New York - India Office.
Hope you are doing great.

I was thinking of writing to you for a long time to know your good time to have an orientation on the American Transfer Program (ATP) for First Year students of JMC .

American Transfer Program was specifically introduced for Indian students coming out Liberal Arts and Science colleges in India, who have only 15 years of Education and will not be eligible for doing Masters in the United States as 16 years of Education is the eligibility criteria for doing Masters in the US.

We have many students transferring to Concordia after 2 years in India where they earn an American degree in 3 years. (1 year at Concordia). We also have students coming in after 3 years in India and spending 1 year at Concordia. These students earn an Indian degree and also an American Undergrad degree.

Last year we had Christiemol Abraham from JMC transferring to Concordia after her Second year and she will be completing her American degree in Fall 2019. She had taken FIVE Concordia Classes Online in her First two years of study in India, which will enable her to complete her studies in NY in 1 year.

Students will have to forward us their Indian Syllabus which will enable us to do a course mapping.

We initiate students into the Program in the First year and Online classes, if needed, can be spaced and taken in 2 years time.

It will be great if you could plan a date for an Orientation where First, Second and third-year students can participate.

On 2nd March 2020 Public Policy and Analysis JMC - in collaboration with Internal Quality Assurance Cell- organized an informative speaker session by Professor Mark Kayser from Hertie School of Governance, Germany. The main ideas of the lecture stemmed from Prof. Kayser's research paper 'Downward Class Mobility and Far-Right Party Support' which bore key insights into the phenomenon of 'Populism in Europe'.

This informative session bore key insights into the phenomenon of 'Populism in Europe'. Elucidating the research methodology and econometric models adopted, Prof. Kayser drew a dynamic and multi-dimensional parallel between inter-generational occupational mobility and the tendency to support far right political parties, in both general and the European contexts. He argued for the existence of non-spurious correlation- both direct and indirect - between cultural and economic factors and the consequent voting patterns in any given region and evidenced the same with data on the trends of inter-generational occupational mobility and populism in Europe during the last few decades.
